OUR COMMITMENT TO YOU

We are 100% committed to your transformation. Throughout Creating a Culture of Renewal®, a three-year, in-depth leadership program, we invest in you through providing innovative and enriching online retreats, one-on-one mentoring, live group coaching, and regular peer support. In addition, we give you access to state-of-the-art learning platforms and professionally designed Creating a Culture of Renewal® workbooks. This is an intensive process of transformation and so we promise you will not be alone – we are with you on the journey.

YOUR COMMITMENT TO US

Your registration commits you to the entire three-year program. Renewal doesn't happen overnight. Personal, congregational, and organizational transformation requires time and intentionality. Your engagement and participation in the program are directly correlated with your success; therefore, you commit to be fully invested in your own growth and development. TRANSFERS

We charge a \$200 transfer fee to cover administrative costs. You will continue your payments during this time unless you have already paid in full.

RESCHEDULE

We reserve the right to reschedule offerings or replace personnel due to extreme weather events, low enrollment, or circumstances beyond our control. If an offering is rescheduled or cancelled, we will do our best to give you as much advance notice as possible. Participants may then enroll in the next available cohort as needed, without penalty.
